Core Charge & Return Process

- A worn arm is not the same thing as a broken arm.
- Cores must have remaining useful life to be refurbished.
- Cores must be returned within 30-days.
- Most cores will require some level of repair work to get them up to an acceptable condition for the next refurbishment.
- Wastebuilt performs an inspection of each arm returned for core eligibility.
- Wastebuilt will summarize which wear parts, if any, need to be replaced to get the core ready for the refurbishment.
